

PSC Covid Precautions March 2022

Due to the vulnerabilities of the families we support and the families of staff and volunteers at Parenting Special Children we will continue with the following precautions until further notice:

- We encourage all who work at PSC or access PSC services to follow public health advice, to minimize the chance of catching Covid and to protect staff/volunteers and families who access PSC services.
- We encourage stringent hand washing and will ensure that handwashing facilities with anti-bac soap and water are in place at all times
- We will use spacious places at face to face events where possible, have a flow of fresh air and encourage space between attendees where possible
- The use of masks is an individual choice both for staff, volunteers, visitors, and families who access PSC services
- It is very important that people do not attend PSC face to face services or staff/volunteers come to the office if they/their child or any other member of your household is unwell.
- Until 1 April we ask that all adults and secondary school age children do a lateral flow test 48 hours prior to attending a PSC event, and test negative.
- PSC staff and volunteers will be asked to do a lateral flow test for face to face events/office attendance whilst there is accessibility to free lateral flow tests. If they test positive they are not to return to face to face events until 2 consecutive negative tests are taken on separate days.

The following statement will be on all PSC face to face events from 1 April:

Please do not attend if you are unwell, or if any member of your household has Covid symptoms.
